Eva's Angels is a charity lovingly dedicated to our beautiful five year old daughter, Eva Giles.

We provide short breaks in our caravan on the Kent coast, for families who are affected by childhood cancer.

Eva lost her battle to Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG) a rare childhood brainstem tumour, in April 2017.

On April 7th 2017, Eva made her final journey. It was with bone weary sadness and unspeakable grief that we made the choice to move her from St. Georges ICU unit back home where doctors would remove her life support machine.

A small team will re-create her final journey by running 68 miles from St. Georges Hospital in London to Herne Bay. It marks the final journey Eva made and the first event of the charity inspired by Eva's short life and epic battle with cancer.
